Banns of Marriage

Application To Marry Outside The Benefice

It is lovely to hear of your plans to get married. We would be very happy to call your banns of marriage if you are getting married outside the benefice.

We have however legal obligations to check your identity and residency before we can publish banns. If you have a UK passport or UK birth certificate and have not been married before, then our Benefice Administrator can verify your identities during the office hours listed below. The Benefice is currently in a Vacancy ie, we have no resident vicar so if you are not available during the stated office hours or do not fulfil the above criteria, it will be necessary for the Area Dean, the Revd Bruce Faulkner, to complete the required paperwork. The fee for Publication of Banns in 2018 is £43 and is revised every year by the Church of England. Please bring cash or a cheque (made payable to Martock PCC, Ash Church Fund or Parochial Church Council of Kingsbury Episcopi) together with the relevant paperwork to confirm your identities, residency and marital status, as appropriate.

We normally call banns on the second, third and fourth Sundays of the month, two months before a wedding (eg if you're getting married on 8th July, we will call your banns on the second, third and fourth Sunday in May).

The Benefice Administrator will send you an email or phone you after your Banns have been read when the certificate is ready to be collected from the Benefice Office. You must give the certificate to the person who is officiating at your wedding.
